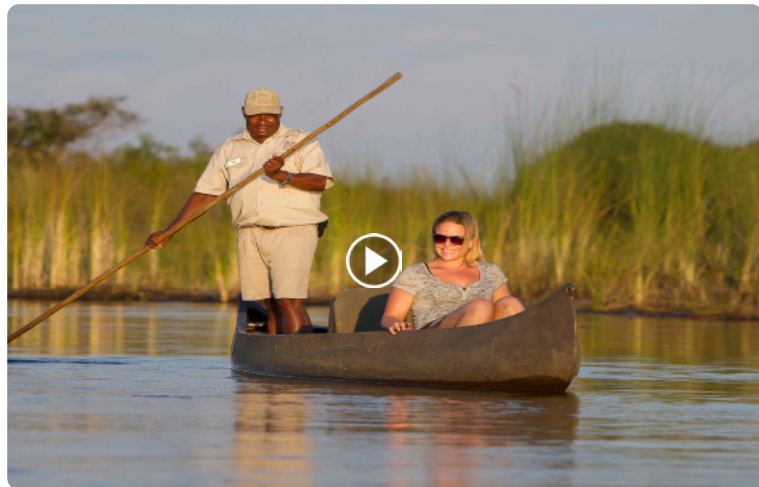


Botswana

WILDLIFE

NOV - APR RAINY SEASON

Second largest zebra migration in the Kalahari.

MAY - OCT DRY SEASON

Elephants gather around waterholes for incredible sightings.

SEP - OCT GREEN SEASON

Thousands of birds migrate to the rivers and lakes surrounding the Makgadikgadi Pans.

OCT - DEC SHORT RAINY SEASON

Rains arrive but less crowds equals great value.

JUN - AUG EXPLORE ART

The "Louvre of the Desert", the Tsodilo Rock Art boasts the highest concentration of rock art in the world.

MAY - OCT GLIDING A MOKORO

Glide along the calm waters of the Delta by boat or a traditional mokoro.

SEP - OCT FISHING SEASON

Keen anglers may choose to tiger-fish during the natural feeding frenzy created by the annual Okavango Barbel Run.

SEP - DEC BIRDING

Excellent time for photography and birding.

Land and water safaris

CHOBE NATIONAL PARK

Africa's elephant paradise

- Chobe National Park has the biggest elephant population, plus predators like lion, wild dog, jackal, hyena and leopard.
- Go on game drives and rivers cruises enjoying massive herds of elephants and multitude of buffalo.
- Silent safaris with a fleet of electric 4x4 vehicles and solar-powered boats.

THE KALAHARI

Unique parks and thriving wildlife

- The second largest reserve in the world and most remote reserve in Southern Africa.
- Likely to see black-maned Kalahari lions as well as cheetah, black-backed jackal, and brown and spotted hyena with rare wild dog and reclusive leopard also on the list.
- Birders can expect to train their binoculars on flamingos, secretary birds, martial eagles, great white pelicans and giant eagle owls.
- Witness the second largest zebra migration in Southern Africa, closely followed by lions, cheetahs and other predators.



- A safari in the Kalahari offers interactive adventure and a wide range of activities from hot air ballooning, quad biking or horseback expeditions, and desert sleep-outs under the stars.
- Guests enjoy guided nature walks with San Bushmen learning about ancient tracking and survival techniques.

LINYANTI

Large number of predators

- Drift down the Linyanti River on the Queen Silvia barge, watching hippos bob and elephants cross.
- Helicopter high above the Savuti Channel where basking crocodiles, possibly never seeing humans before, slide into the water.
- Go on 4x4 drives, nature walks, and for a unique perspective, spend some time in the underground hide.
