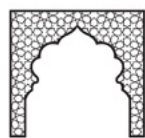

APRIL MARATHON DES SABLES

a six day multi-stage race through the harsh landscapes of the Sahara Desert.

ISLAMIC CALENDAR RAMADAN

Ramadan refers to the ninth month in the Muslim calendar, when Muslims must abstain from food, drink, and other physical needs during daylight hours.

OCTOBER DATA FESTIVAL

Held in Erfoud where the Tafilalet's delicious dates are harvested and during this time locals celebrate with performances of Gnaoua and Berber music and plenty of free dates to taste.

NOV - DEC MARRAKECH INTERNATIONAL FILM FESTIVAL

The event offers a wide film selection of different genres and nationalities, tributes, favourites in Moroccan cinema and films.

EVENTS & FESTIVALS

FEBRUARY BLOSSOM FESTIVAL

Visit Tafraout for the annual Almond Blossom Festival. Expect delicious food, traditional Berber folk music and, heaps of sweet-smelling almond blossoms.

MARCH INTERNATIONAL NOMAD FESTIVAL

Great weather for exploring iconic landmarks and getting lost in the streets of Marrakech and Fes. Align your trip with the International Nomad Festival in a remote Saharan village of M'Hamid El Ghizlane.

MAY M'GOUN VALLEY ROSE FESTIVAL

The two-day festival includes rose parades and all kinds of rose products as well as the celebrated Miss Roses beauty pageant.

MARRAKECH
