### *What to Pack for a Journey to*

#### EGYPT, MOROCCO, JORDAN & DUBAI

We're thrilled you're embarking on your journey through North Africa and the Middle East, with travel across destinations such as Egypt, Morocco, Dubai, and Jordan. This region offers a blend of climates, cultural experiences, and environments, so thoughtful packing will ensure comfort and ease throughout.

As with any international travel, it is recommended to leave unnecessary valuables at home and keep personal belongings secure while traveling.

Across all destinations, modest and respectful dress is encouraged, particularly when visiting religious, cultural, and heritage sites. Clothing with offensive slogans or imagery should be avoided.

#### CLOTHING AND FOOTWEAR

Lightweight, breathable clothing in natural fabrics such as linen or cotton is ideal for warm daytime temperatures. Conditions can vary significantly between cities, deserts, and coastal regions, with cooler evenings and air-conditioned interiors common, so layering is essential. Comfort and practicality are key, particularly for full-day touring and time spent outdoors.

Suggested clothing includes:

- o Loose-fitting shirts, blouses, trousers, skirts, or dresses in breathable fabrics
- o Modest attire covering shoulders and knees for religious, cultural, and heritage sites
- o Smart-casual attire for upscale restaurants, hotels, and Nile cruises (Note: cocktail or elegant outfit recommended for Nile cruise evenings; shorts not permitted at dinner onboard)





- o Swimwear for hotel pools, resorts, or beach stays
- o Comfortable walking shoes or sturdy sandals
- o A lightweight scarf or shawl for religious site visits, sun protection, and cooler indoor spaces
- o Warmer layers (sweater, jacket) for cooler evenings, air-conditioned interiors, and desert nights

#### ACCESSORIES & TRAVEL ESSENTIALS

- o Sunglasses and a wide-brim hat for sun protection
- o High-SPF sunscreen
- o Small day bag or backpack for daily excursions
- o Plug adapters (electrical outlets vary by destination; a universal adapter is recommended)
- o Charging cables and power bank
- o Waterproof or dustproof bags for electronics and cameras
- o Packing cubes and laundry bags for organization

*Note: in Egypt, drones and binoculars are prohibited and may be confiscated upon arrival.*





## HEALTHCARE & PERSONAL CARE

- Prescription medications: bring enough for the full trip in original packaging with a doctor's prescription and carry them in hand luggage; cannabis-containing medications are not recommended, even if prescribed
- Basic medical kit (pain relief, antiseptic cream, bandages, antihistamines, anti-diarrheal medication, motion sickness tablets)
- Hand sanitizer
- Insect repellent
- Lip balm and moisturizer
- Personal toiletries and hygiene items
- Extra glasses or contact lenses and cleaning solution
- Make a copy of your passport and keep it in a safe place
